Post-doctoral Fellowship in Psychological Assessment

A Healing Paradigm Wellness Center is accepting applications for a two-year post-doctoral fellowship with an emphasis on psychological assessment and therapy. Our program provides advanced clinical training opportunities in Atlanta, Georgia. Clinical cases primarily involve individuals who present with a variety of psychiatric illnesses, accompanying cognitive symptoms, and/or comorbid medical illnesses (e.g., PTSD, ADHD, learning disorders, mood disorders, pain disorders, traumatic brain injury, substance abuse, and dementias). Populations served range in age from early childhood to geriatric.

These positions emphasize development of clinical skills working in the areas of trauma and competency working with people of African ancestry. Fellows will receive extensive training in assessment, consultation, counseling, and community outreach. Fellows may have the opportunity to engage in research activities and curriculum development depending on level of interest. The theoretical focus of the practice is on African-centered psychology, Womanist theory, or indigenous healing methodologies.

Prior psychological assessment experience and superior writing skills is a must. Exceptional interpersonal and client care skills are also required. The successful candidate must have the ability to balance multiple tasks, possess exceptional organizational skills, and be a self starter.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Administration, scoring, and interpretation of objective psychological measures
- Documentation of clinical records and report writing
- Extensive development and facilitation of community outreach
- Preparation of scholarly manuscripts
- Individual therapy (if desired)

Qualities Required

Requirements include completion of an APA-accredited doctoral program in psychology and an APA-approved internship. The ideal candidate **must** have significant prior assessment experience. Skill working with children and adults of culturally and economically diverse backgrounds, evidenced by prior training experiences is a must. Flexibility to work some evenings and rare weekends is required. Interest in forensic work is a plus. Candidate must be proactive, goal oriented, and personable. The ability to work independently, multi-task, and be comfortable in a rapidly developing environment is vital to this position. Personal attributes desired include being well-spoken, punctual, goal-oriented, and reliable.

Compensation: This contract position offers a competitive salary. Additional benefits include healthcare coverage (medical, dental, vision) and eligibility for student loan repayment.
